## TEACHING ASSIGNMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONAL SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

The board has the responsibility for ultimately determining what academic content and skills students in the Pateros school district will be required to master and who will be assigned the responsibility for ensuring students do master the essential academic content and skills. Although educational advice will be sought from teachers and school administrators on a regular basis regarding the nature of academic content and skills, the board will need to annually approve teacher assignments and the instructional schedule of classes. The board will consider approving or not approving either teacher assignments, the instructional schedule of classes, or both based on their perceptions of student and community needs and resources.

The school superintendent will present to the board in June proposed teacher assignments and an instructional schedule of classes for the ensuing academic school year. It is recognized that both teacher assignments and an instructional schedule of classes is tentative and either may be revised prior to the start of the next academic school year due to teacher turnover and fluctuations in student enrollments during the summer months.

The June board approval date will allow adequate time for needed revisions to occur if needed and preliminary student registration activities to begin prior to the end of the current school year.
